Health Reform Implementation Committee (HRIC)

- A Mayor's Order created the HRIC to oversee the execution of the federal Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act, approved March 23, 2010, and the Health Care and Education Reconciliation Act of 2010, approved March 30, 2010. A new Mayor's Order was established May 4, 2011, to relaunch the HRIC.
- Chaired by Director of Department of Health Care Finance and co-chaired by Directors of Department of Insurance, Securities and Banking and Dr. Mohammad Akhter of the Department of Health.
- Additional committee members include Department of Human Services, the Department of Mental Health and the Department of Disability Services.




HRIC IT Subcommittee

- Formed on February 16, 2012
- Chaired by Department of Human Services
- Role: Engage the stakeholders in the implementation of the health reform information technology infrastructure to ensure project success
- Focus:
 - Guiding implementation of the IT project supporting health reform.
 - Establish Work Groups to support IT design and development that requires cross-agency collaboration.
 - Provide feedback to the implementation team
 - Review project status and submitting recommendations to the HRIC
- Goal:
 - To establish the IT components of the DC Access Project (DCAP), which will enable a new Health Care and Human Services Solution for the District

The purpose of this project is put in place a secure and modular technology infrastructure to provide state of the art access to health and social benefits for the District residents and employees.




