- III. Employer Plan Selection in SHOP Please refer to attached handouts
  - a. Discussion of District Progress on SHOP flows
    - Background handout (July 23, 2012 (1)): DISB is using 2011 California Study (pages 18-24) as a basis for the information contained in the handout. The Study is posted on the website and formal requests for copies should be made to Brendan Rose
      - Merged risk pools are mentioned in the background handout but it was made clear at the meeting that DISB has not made a final recommendation on a merged risk pool and all comments referring to a merged risk pool are germane
      - 2. Stakeholders in attendance asked how will high deductible plans/HSA's play into SHOPs (outside of the rules within ACA)
    - ii. Questions handout (July 23, 2012 (2)): DISB's two stated options are a starting point and not absolute. DISB is asking for public comment
    - iii. DISB expects to release their review of the process follow on/around Monday, August 20, 2012
    - b. All public comments are due by COB Monday, August 13, 2012

  - a. Network Adequacy it is expected to be released on/around Friday, July 29, 2012 in the form of an issue brief

- v. DISB expects a final submission to CCIIO by October 1, 2012
- b. Stand-alone Dental/Drug Formularies
  - i. DISB expects to provide a draft to stakeholders by the end of August, 2012
