The DC Health Benefit Exchange Authority Board approved the Producer Advisory Committee's requirements that producers will need to fulfill to sell in DC Health Link.

Producers will need to complete 6 hours of training, consisting of 2 parts: District specific policies and DC Health Link website training. NAHU has been selected as the DC Health Link training partner and will soon publish its training schedule.

- 1. Hold and maintain an active DC License, which must be in good standing at all times
- 2. Prior to registration, a producer must obtain appointments with each carrier in DC Health Link for the market in which he/she intends to sell (small group and/or indi-
