BACKGROUND INFORMATION FOR COVID-19 SPECIAL ENROLLMENT PERIOD EXTENSION

Current COVID-19 SEP

- The exceptional circumstances special enrollment period (SEP) for both the individual and SHOP markets for COVID-19 is set to end January 31, 2021 (the end of the DC Health Link's Open Enrollment period) or the last day of the month in which the District of Columbia's public health emergency (PHE) expires, whichever is later.
- *Effective Date of Coverage* The effective date of coverage is the first day of the month in which the individual or employee selects a plan <u>or</u> first day of the month following plan selection, at the option of the qualified individual or employee. If enrolling in family coverage, dependents have the same effective date as the enrolling individual or employee.
- Presently, the public health emergency in the District is scheduled to expire on July 25, 2021. Without an extension, the COVID-19 SEP will expire July 31, 2021.

Proposal

- On May 6, 2021, the Standing Advisory Board voted 7 to 1 to extend the existing COVID-19 SEPs in the individual and SHOP markets through January 31, 2022 - the end of DC Health Link's next open enrollment period or the last day of the month in which the District's PHE expires, whichever is later.
- The SAB recommendation does not change the effective date of coverage.
