

AV Analysis #3 – October 14, 2022

AV analysis of unified treatment scenario of 10/11/2022: includes Gender Dysphoria, Autism, ADHD, Anxiety, Depression, PTSD, conduct disorder; single service break, includes all drugs listed in the scenario, and the additional services for Gender Dysphoria.

We have updated the analysis to incorporate the desired changes and summarize the impact to the 2023 standard plans of including certain services for selected mental health conditions in children and adolescents at \$0 or \$10 cost sharing. Six different scenarios are provided below as a result of using a \$0 or \$10 cost sharing for the services, and differing limits for the number of services covered (15, 20, or 26). The impact of these services, which mainly impacts the “Mental/Behavioral Health and Substance Use Disorder Outpatient Services” category in the AV Calculator, is summarized below. In general, the results do not change significantly between scenarios.

The silver plan has a metal AV outside the de minimis range under all scenarios while the gold plan has a metal AV outside the de minimis range for the scenarios with a \$0 copay. The impact of increasing the number of visits ranged from 0.00% to 0.03%, depending on the metal level and copay.
