Mary Beth,

We have updated our AV Calculator determination to reflect the desired list of CPT codes for PCP, Specialist, and Lab services as well as the NDC list from Kaiser. For clarity, revisions to identification of claims as diabetic services were as follows:

- For PCP and specialist visits, only procedure codes 99201-99205, 99211-99215, and 97802-97804 (nutritional counseling) where there is also a diabetic primary diagnosis code were included
- For lab services, only claims for the CPT codes from CareFirst where there is also a diabetic primary diagnosis code were included
- For preferred prescription drugs, only the NDCs flagged by Kaiser to be included at \$0 cost sharing were utilized

The most impactful adjustment was the NDC list as it was trimmed from over 1,000 NDCs to only about 185 NDCs based on those identified by Kaiser to be included at \$0 cost sharing. With these updates, all standard metal level plans remain in the necessary range as summarized below:
