Join The DC Health Link Student Intern Partnership Program (SIP)

The **SIP program** is an opportunity for college students and recent graduates to help advance the mission of the DC Health Exchange Authority to provide District residents access with quality, affordable health insurance. In addition to developing professional skills in the health policy arena, students will engage in educational and outreach activities. The program incorporates opportunities for professional and personal growth through workshops and training geared toward community networking, stakeholder engagement and grassroots outreach.

Qualifications

- Must be 18 years of age or older with a career focus on health policy and public affairs.
- Demonstrated interest and/or experience in community outreach, grassroots engagement, communications, or any related area of study or interest.
- Currently pursuing or holding a bachelor's or graduate degree in public affairs, public health, communications, or related field.
- Strong oral and written communication skills; Proficiency in Spanish, Amharic or other languages a plus
- Effective interpersonal skills and comfortable/confident speaking to small group
- Stipend - \$20.00 - \$25.00 per hour

Responsibilities

- Focus on community outreach, engagement, education, and communications.
- Participate in outreach activities and campaigns to reach, educate, and enroll uninsured DC residents.
- Attend events and activities to share information about DC Health Link, open enrollment and the importance and value of enrolling of health insurance.
- Participate in internship orientation, training, and strategy meetings.
- Complete SIP application; submit 2 reference letters
- Submit time, outreach, and activity reports.
