CONTRACT TYPE, SUPPLIES OR SERVICES AND PRICE/COST

B.1.1 The DC Health Benefit Exchange Authority (HBX) requires the contractor to provide "best of class" personnel to perform information technology (IT) staffing services in various labor categories. HBX has grouped these labor categories into five (5) Aggregate Groups.

B.2 INDEFINITE DELIVERY – INDEFINITE QUANTITY (IDIQ) CONTRACT

- B.2.1 New Light Technologies ("Contractor") shall furnish to HBX, when and if ordered, the services specified in the schedule up to and including to the maximum amount of the contract.
 - MINIMUM ORDER: HBX guarantees a \$500.00 minimum order for the Base Period and for each Option Period. HBX is not obligated to order any products, goods, commodities or services beyond the stated minimum amount.
 - **MAXIMUM ORDER**: The maximum amount of any task order or purchase order shall be no greater than the maximum contract ceiling amount.
- **B.2.2** There is no limit on the number of orders that may be issued. HBX may issue orders requiring delivery to multiple destinations or performance at multiple locations. The maximum contract ceiling amount is \$3,000,000.00. The cumulative total of all task orders/purchase orders issued against this contract shall not exceed the total contract amount of \$3,000,000.00.
- B.2.3 Any task orders issued during the effective period of this contract and not completed within the period shall be completed by the Contractor within the time specified in the task order. The task order shall be completed by the Contractor and HBX's rights and obligations with respect to the task order exist to the same extent as if the order were completed during the contract's effective period; provided that the Contractor shall not be required to make any deliveries under this contract after completion of all services needed in accordance with the scope, and provided that the referral was made during the effective period of the contract.



SPECIFICATIONS/STATEMENT OF WORK

C.1 SCOPE

The DC Health Benefit Exchange Authority (HBX) requires Contractor to provide "best of class" personnel to perform information technology (IT) staffing services in various labor categories. HBX has grouped these labor categories into five (5) Aggregate Groups (See Attachment F.6).

C.2 BACKGROUND


- C.2.1 The District of Columbia Health Benefit Exchange Authority (HBX) is a quasi-governmental, independent authority of the District of Columbia government, established as a requirement of Section 3 of the Health Benefit Exchange Authority Establishment Act of 2011, effective March 3, 2012 (D.C. Law 19-0094). The mission of the DC Health Benefit Exchange Authority is to implement a state-based health insurance marketplace in the District of Columbia in accordance with the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act of 2010 (ACA), thereby ensuring access to quality and affordable health care to all DC residents.
- C.2.2 As an instrumentality of the District government, the HBX supports the development, economic growth, and retention of District-based businesses and would like to identify Certified Business Enterprises (CBEs) that are able to provide IT and technical support for Release 1 of the District of Columbia Access System (DCAS) and related projects. DCAS is planned as city-wide state-of-the-art health and human services solution. In its current release, version 1.E, DC Health Link supports an on-line health insurance marketplace where individuals and small businesses can shop for and enroll in private health insurance coverage. It also allows consumers to apply for federal advanced premium tax credits and Medicaid. Upcoming releases will simplify and enhance both consumer and business users by including enhanced business functions and consumer shopping aids.



- C.3.10 Commercial, off-the-shelf (COTS) software or hardware that is ready-made and available for sale.
- C.3.11 Channel service unity (CSU) a digital-interface device used to connect a data terminal equipment device, such as a router, to a digital circuit.
- **C.3.12** Database (DB) a structured collection of records or data that is stored in a computer system.
- C.3.13 DB2 Enterprise Server Edition (DB2) a relational database management system, one of IBM's families of relational database management system software products.
- **C.3.14** Database administrator (DBA) person responsible for the environmental aspects of a database.
- C.3.15 Database management system (DBMS) computer software that manages databases. A DBMS allows users and software to store and retrieve data in a structured way.
- C.3.16 Dynamic Host Configuration Protocol (DHCP) a network application protocol used by devices to obtain configuration information for operation in an Internet Protocol network. This protocol reduces system administration workload, allowing devices to be added to the network with little or no manual intervention.
- C.3.17 Dynamic hypertext markup language (DHTML) a collection of technologies used to create interactive and animated websites by using a combination of a static markup language (such as HTML), a client-side scripting language (such as JavaScript), a presentation of definition language (such as CSS) and the Document Object Model.
- C.3.18 Domain name system (DNS) a hierarchical naming system for computers, services, or any resource participating in the Internet. It associates various information with the domain names assigned to each of the participants.
- C.3.19 A data service unity (DSU) a piece of telecommunications circuit terminating equipment that transforms digital data between telephone company lines and local equipment.
- C.3.20 Enterprise data warehouse (EDW) a repository of an organization's electronically stored data, designed to facilitate reporting and analysis.
- C.3.21 Enterprise resource planning (ERP) a system that is used to manage and coordinate all the resources, information and functions of a business.




- C.3.23 Geographic information system (GIS) a system for creating, storing, analyzing and managing spatial data and associated attributes.
- C.3.24 Graphical user interface (GUI) user interface that allows people to interact with electronic devices such as computer and handhelds with images rather than text commands.
- **C.3.25** Hewlett Packard (HP) a technology corporation.
- C.3.26 Hypertext markup language (HTML) the predominant markup language for web pages, which provides a means to describe the structure of text-based information in a document and to supplement text with interactive forms, embedded images and other objects.
- C.3.27 Hypertext transfer protocol (HTTP) protocol (utilizing TCP) to transfer hypertext requests and information between serves and browsers.
- C.3.28 Internet information services (IIS) a set of Internet-based services for servers created by Microsoft for use with Windows.
- C.3.29 Information Security (INFOSEC) protecting information and information systems from unauthorized access, use, disclosure, disruption, modification or destruction.
- C.3.30 Internet protocol (IP) IP is the primary protocol in the Internet Layer of the Internet Protocol Suite and has the task of delivering distinguished protocol datagrams (packets) from the source host to the destination host solely based on their addresses.
- C.3.31 Information technology (IT) the study, design, development, implementation, support or management of computer-based information systems, particularly software applications and computer hardware.
- C.3.32 Java Platform, Enterprise Edition (J2EE) a widely used platform for server programming in the Java programming language.
- C.3.33 Java stored procedure (JSP) a set of SQL statements, written in the Java programming language, grouped together as an executable unit.
- **C.3.34** Key performance indicators (KPI) financial and non-financial measures or metrics used to help an organization define and evaluate how successful it is, typically in terms of effectiveness.
- C.3.35 Local area network (LAN) a computer network covering a small local area, such as a home or office.
- C.3.36 Microsoft certified systems engineer (MCSE) certification for Windows Server 2003, which qualifies an individual to analyze the business requirements for information systems solutions, and design and implement the infrastructure required.



- C.3.38 Network operations center (NOC) one or more locations from which control is exercised over a computer, television broadcast or telecommunications network.
- C.3.39 Network monitoring system (NMS) a system that constantly monitors a computer network for slow or failing components and notifies the network administrator in case of outages via email, pager or other alarms.
- C.3.40 Online analytical processing (OLAP) a type of software and tools used to perform real-time, complex analysis of data stored in one or more databases.
- C.3.41 Online transaction processing (OLTP) a type of software and tools used to perform real-time creation and editing of data in a database.
- C.3.42 Operation system (OS) a software program that enables the computer hardware to communicate and operate with the computer software.
- C.3.43 Portable document format (PDF) a file format creates by Adobe Systems for document exchange. PDF is used for representing two-dimensional documents in a manner independent of the application software, hardware and operating system.
- C.3.44 Perl- a high-level, general-purpose, interpreted, dynamic programming language, developed as a general purpose Linux scripting language to make report processing easier.
- C.3.45 Personal computer (PC) a computer whose original sales prices, size and capabilities make it useful for individuals.
- C.3.46 PHP- a scripting language originally designed for producing dynamic web pages. It has evolved to include a command line interface capability and can be used in a stand-alone graphical applications.
- C.3.47 Project Management Professional (PMP) a certification offered by the Project Management Institute.
- C.3.48 Quality assurance (QA) planned and systematic processes that provide confidence in a product's suitability for its intended purpose.
- C.3.49 Quality control (QC) used in developing systems to ensure software is designed and produced to meet or exceed customer requirements.
- C.3.50 Storage area network an architecture to attach remote computer storage devices (such as disk arrays, tape libraries and optical jukeboxes) to servers in such a way that the devices appear as locally attached to the operating system.

- C.3.51 Service level agreement (SLA) a part of a service contract where the level of service is formally defined. In practice, the term SLA is sometimes used often refer to the contracted delivery time (out of service) or performance.
- C.3.52 System Modification Program/ Extended (SMP/E) a standard utility used in conjunction with IBM's z/OS operating system. SMP/E is the common installation tool for managing operating system components and middleware on z/OS.
- C.3.53 Standard operating procedures (SOP) a set of instructions having the force of a directive that describes the normal procedure for performing a task or job within the constraints of the organization's policies.
- **C.3.54** Storage Networking Industry Association (SNIA) an association of producers and consumers of storage networking products, whose goal is to further storage networking technology and applications.
- C.3.55 Secure sockets layer (SSL) cryptographic protocol that provides security and data integrity for communications over networks such as the Internet.
- C.3.56 Structure Query Language (SQL) a database computer language designed for the retrieval and management of data in relational database management systems.
- C.3.57 Transmission control protocol and Internet protocol (TCP/IP) the Internet Protocol Suite (commonly known as TCP/IP) is the set of communications protocols used for the Internet and other similar networks.
- C.3.58 Visual Basic .NET (VB.NET) an object-oriented computer language that can be viewed as an evolution of Microsoft's Visual Basic (VB) implemented on the Microsoft .NET Framework.
- C.3.59 Virtual local area network (VLAN) a group of hosts with a common set of requirements that communicate as if they were attached to the broadcast domain, regardless of their physical location.
- C.3.60 VMware- the leader in virtual software, which provides a completely virtualized set of hardware to the guest operating system.
- C.3.61 Voice over Internet Protocol (VoIP) a family of transmission technologies for delivery of voice communications over IP networks such as the Internet or other packet-switched networks.
- C.3.62 Virtual Telecommunications Access Method (VTAM) IBM's software package that provides communications via telecommunication devices for mainframe environments.
- C.3.63 Wide area network (WAN) a computer network that covers a broad area.
- **C.3.64** Windows Internet Name Service (WINS) a central mapping of host names to network addresses.



- C.3.66 Extensible Markup Language (XML) a general-purpose specification for creating custom markup languages.
- C.3.67 Extensible stylesheet language (XSL) a family of transformation languages that allow one to describe how to format or transform files encoded in the XML standard.
- C.3.68 XML schema definition (XSD) one of several XML schema languages.


C.4 REQUIREMENTS

The Contractor shall provide "best of class" personnel to perform information technology (IT) staffing services in various labor categories set forth in Attachment F.6 to this Contract ("Aggregate Groups Labor Categories, Requirements, and Experiences"). HBX has grouped these labor categories into five (5) Aggregate Groups:

- Aggregate Group One- Project Management Operations (PMO)
- Aggregate Group Two- Applications Development and Operations (APPS)
- Aggregate Group Three- Operations, Maintenance, Hosting Infrastructure
- Aggregate Group Four- IT Security
- Aggregate Group Five- Internet, Intranet Services
- C.4.1 The Contractor shall provide qualified personnel to fulfill the programmatic needs of HBX in the required work to assist management in identifying objectives, vision, mission, and goals as they relate to the DCAS project.
- C.4.1.1 The Contractor shall provide expert consulting services when needed by HBX management. Expert consulting is defined as services of a specialized nature supplementing the purpose and scope of this contract, but outside the boundaries of the staff identified.

C.5 PERSONNEL REQUIREMENTS

- C.5.1 The Contractor shall provide personnel with the technical experience, training, and/or education for positions outlined in Attachment F.6. Unless otherwise noted, experience may be substituted for the educational requirements on the basis of one year experience for one year of college. The education requirements for key personnel, as identified by the Contract Administrator, cannot be substituted with experience and must meet all requirements.
- C.5.2 The Contractor shall indicate where experience has been substituted for education. Additionally, the Contractor must show that the experience level substituted for education exceeds the basic experience requirements.
- C.5.3 Contractor shall identify personnel by complete name and a resume attached for review prior to the issuance of the task order. Contents of resume may be independently verified by DCHBX.



- C.5.5 The Contractor shall ensure that rates for personnel do not exceed the rates outlined in B.3. Such rates for a specific person will be negotiated between the Contractor Administrator and the Contractor.
- C.5.6 The Contractor shall, at no additional charge to HBX, arrange for a background check for each of the candidates that will provide services to HBX under this contract once selected for work under a Task Order, but prior to issuing a purchase order for such services. The Contractor shall maintain a methodology of screening candidates using background checks to verify and validate information about the candidate.
- C.5.7 The persons selected for these positions shall be employed by the Contractor or enter into an agreement with the Contractor directly or through a subcontractor at the time the task order is issued.
- C.5.8 The District reserves the right to hire Contractor's personnel at any time.
- C.5.9 The Department of Human Services (DHS) and Department of Health Care Finance (DHCF) may utilize Contractor personnel when: i) specifically approved in advance by the Contract Administrator; and ii) funded by DHS or DHCF.

C.6 SUPPORT HOURS

- C.6.1 At a minimum, the Contractor shall provide personnel at 609 H Street NE, Washington, DC, 20002, five (5) days a week, Monday through Friday, for eight (8) hours per day. Contractor personnel may work remotely only when authorized in writing by the Contract Administrator. Contractor personnel may work between 7:30 a.m. and 12:00 a.m. if approved in advance by the Contract Administrator, and provided that: i) each full-time Contractor personnel works at least an 8 hour shift; and ii) it does not affect the efficiency of operations.
- **C.6.2** Contractor personnel shall observe all District Government holidays and, in the event of backlogs, overtime will be authorized only by the HBX Contracting Officer (CO).

C.7 PERIODIC REPORTING, MEETING AND REVIEW

The Contractor shall communicate regularly and report on activities in order to achieve the highest level of services, with at least 1 regularly scheduled meeting per week. All reports shall be produced in the format requested by the Contract Administrator, in the latest applications within the Microsoft Office Suite, and provided in both hard and soft copy.

C.7.1 If at any point during performance of the contract the contractor believes that insufficient funds remain on the contract, the contractor must notify the Contracting Officer and the Contract Administrator in writing, when it has reason to believe that the cost for providing the required services will exceed the remaining dollar amount on the contract.





- C.8.1 HBX shall provide office space at 609 H Street NE, access to the IT systems, and VPN access, as needed for to perform under this contract.
- C.8.2 HBX shall provide complete systems and products documentation as needed to perform this contract, including appropriate access to applications and systems in accordance with IT security procedures.

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SECTION D

PERIOD OF PERFORMANCE AND DELIVERABLES

D.1 TERM OF CONTRACT

The term of the contract shall be for one (1) year from the Date of Award specified on the cover page of the contract.

D.2 OPTION TO EXTEND THE TERM OF THE CONTRACT

- D.2.1 HBX may extend the term of this contract for four (4) one-year option periods, or successive fractions thereof, by written notice to the Contractor before the expiration of the contract; provided that HBX will give the Contractor preliminary written notice of its intent to extend at least thirty (30) days before the contract expires. The preliminary notice does not commit HBX to an extension. The exercise of this option is subject to the availability of funds at the time of the exercise of this option. The Contractor may waive the thirty (30) day preliminary notice requirement by providing a written waiver to the Contracting Officer prior to expiration of the contract.
- **D.2.2** If HBX exercises an option period, the extended contract shall be considered to include this option provision.
- D.2.3 HBX will establish the contract ceiling amount at the time that each option is exercised.
- **D.2.4** The total duration of this contract, including the exercise of any options under this clause, shall not exceed five (5) years.

D.3 <u>DELIVERABLES</u>

The Contractor shall submit to HBX, as a deliverable, the report described in Section 14 of the HBX Standard Contract Provisions 2016 that is required by the 51% District Residents New Hires Requirements and First Source Employment Agreement. If the Contractor does not submit the report as part of the deliverables, final payment to the Contractor shall not be paid.

SECTION E

CONTRACTING OFFICER AND CONTRACT ADMINISTRATOR

E.1 CONTRACTING OFFICER (CO)

E.2 AUTHORIZED CHANGES BY THE CONTRACTING OFFICER

- **E.2.1** The CO is the only person authorized to approve changes in any of the requirements of this contract.
- **E.2.2** The Contractor shall not comply with any order, directive or request that changes or modifies the requirements of this contract, unless issued in writing and signed by the CO.
- **E.2.3** In the event the Contractor effects any change at the instruction or request of any person other than the CO, the change will be considered to have been made without authority and no adjustment will be made in the contract price to cover any cost increase incurred as a result thereof.

E.3 CONTRACT ADMINSTRATOR (CA)

- **E.3.1** The CA is responsible for general administration of the contract and advising the CO as to the Contractor's compliance or noncompliance with the contract. The CA has the responsibility of ensuring the work conforms to the requirements of the contract and such other responsibilities and authorities as may be specified in the contract. These include:
- **E.3.1.1** Keeping the CO fully informed of any technical or contractual difficulties encountered during the performance period and advising the CO of any potential problem areas under the contract;
- **E.3.1.2** Coordinating site entry for Contractor personnel, if applicable;
- **E.3.1.3** Reviewing invoices for completed work and recommending approval by the CO if the Contractor's costs are consistent with the negotiated amounts and progress is satisfactory and commensurate with the rate of expenditure;



- **E.3.1.4** Reviewing and approving invoices for deliverables to ensure receipt of goods and services. This includes the timely processing of invoices and vouchers in accordance with the HBX payment provisions; and
- **E.31.5** Maintaining a file that includes all contract correspondence, modifications, records of inspections (site, data, equipment) and invoice or vouchers.

- **E.3.3** The CA shall NOT have the authority to:

 - Increase the dollar limit of the contract or authorize work beyond the dollar limit of the contract,
 - 4. Authorize the expenditure of funds by the Contractor;
 - 5. Change the period of performance; or
 - 6. Authorize the use of District property, except as specified under the contract.
- **E.3.4** The Contractor shall be fully responsible for any changes not authorized in advance, in writing, by the CO; may be denied compensation or other relief for any additional work performed that is not so authorized; and may also be required, at no additional cost to HBX, to take all corrective action necessitated by reason of the unauthorized changes.
